**Cleveland Metropolitan School District Selected as AIIM Best Practices Award
Finalist for use of OCR for AnyDoc®**

Nelson Best Practices Award.

The Carl E. Nelson Best Practices Award presented by AIIM, the Association for Enterprise Content Management, recognizes excellence in the Enterprise Content Management (ECM) field. The term "Best Practices" denotes a standard of excellence that has been achieved within an organization and refers to a process or implementation that can be quantified, adapted, and repeated.
